* The additional time between services will allow adequate time for the first service's attendees to exit the building before the next group arrives. It also gives our staff adequate time to sanitize between services.

** We will follow the State of Texas guidance for seating, which advises that seating follow a pattern of every other row and two seats of spacing between families.

*** On May 24, the State of Texas hopes to be in Phase 2 of reopening, which allows for 50% capacity. Still, we encourage our 65+ members to continue to participate in online services until the risk to them has lessened.
